**Homework : Create a Photo Essay – 4-6 Images please!**

A photo essay is a collection of images based around a theme, a topic, a creative approach, or an exploration of an idea. Photo essays balance visual variety with a cohesive style and concept.

Examples of photo essay themes include the 'education photo essay', which focuses on educational settings, capturing classroom activities, and student life, and the 'landmark photo essay', which aims to capture landmarks from various perspectives to highlight their unique character and story.

**Eight Simple steps to create your photo essays:**

1. Choose a theme, topic, or concept you want to explore.
2. Create your images.
3. Pull together your wide edit.
4. Post-process your images for a cohesive look.
5. Finalize your selection.
6. Put your images in a purposeful order.
7. Get feedback.
8. Refine, revise, and finalise.
